The Salute to the Flag was led by Councilor Zarrella. The Clerk called the roll and eleven (11) members were present. Board consists of 11 members. The City Clerk read the warrant for the Organizational Meeting.

The Oath of Office was administered to the Mayor, School Committee Members and City Councilors. \_\_\_\_\_\_

Nominations for Council President were declared open by the City Clerk. The name of Councilor Anthony Zarrella was placed in nomination and seconded. There were no further nominations. Nominations were declared closed following a unanimous roll call vote. A vote of unanimous consent resulted in the election of Councilor Anthony Zarrella as President of the City Council for the year 2022. President Zarrella assumed the Chair for the remainder of the meeting.

Nominations for Council Vice President were declared open by President Zarrella. The name of Councilor Andrew Van Hazinga was placed in nomination and seconded. There were no further nominations. Nominations were declared closed following a unanimous roll call vote. A vote of unanimous consent resulted in the election of Councilor Andrew Van Hazinga as Vice President of the City Council for the year 2022.

In accordance with Section 1.3 of the Council Rules, President Zarrella appointed Councilor Sally Cragin as Parliamentarian for the year 2022.

Rule 3.20 (formerly Rule 3.21 approved unanimously by the Legislative Affairs Committee on October 12, 2021)

A member shall not, in a single speech, repeat or reiterate points, other than in passing or in brief summation, nor shall subsequent speech on the same matter or a related matter make more than a passing reference to points already made on a previous occasion during the same meeting.
